

Typology of toxic behaviors at school

Between students

- ☐ **Rumors and defamation:** spreading false information to damage someone's reputation.
- ☐ **Theft or extortion:** forcibly taking possessions or money.
- ☐ **Sexism / inappropriate sexual remarks:** sexually charged jokes, comments about the body.
- ☐ **Manipulation:** pushing a student to misbehave, using them as a "scapegoat."

Teacher → Student

- ☐ **Academic devaluation:** telling a student they are "incapable" or "without a future."
- ☐ **Repeated injustice:** grading arbitrarily, ignoring the efforts made.
- ☐ **Violation of dignity:** remarks about appearance, family situation, or health.
- ☐ **Excessive intrusion:** not respecting a student's privacy (for example, publicly disclosing personal information).

Student → Teacher

- ☐ **Constant provocations:** interruptions, refusal to obey, deliberate insolence.
- ☐ **Mockery about the teacher's age, appearance, or voice.**
- ☐ **Online denigration:** sharing doctored or humiliating videos on social media.
- ☐ **Threats:** verbal or written intimidation to exert pressure.
